**2023-2024 District Assessment Committee** (4 meetings per year) The primary purpose of this committee is to oversee and manage the assessment and testing processes within the district and how we can best use the data to best serve our students and teachers. The specific responsibilities and functions of the District Assessment Committee may vary depending on federal, state and district needs and policies but will generally include the following:

- Assessment Planning/Calendar: Reviewing and district wide assessment plan that aligns with state and federal requirements and the districts educational goals and school calendar
- Test Selection: recommending or selecting appropriate assessment tools for students
- Data Analysis: Collecting, analyzing, and interpreting assessment data to assess student performance, identify areas for improvement and make data informed instructional decisions based on standards.
- Assessment Policies: developing and reviewing district policies related to assessment, testing and data reporting
- Communication: sharing assessment information results with teachers, parents, administrators and the community
- Equity and Fairness: ensuring that assessment practices are fair and equitable for all students
- Accountability: monitoring the implementation of assessment practices, ensuring compliance with relevant regulations and making recommendations for improvement
- **Professional Development:** providing training and support to other educators in your building on best assessment practices and data interpretation.
- **Reporting:** preparing and disseminating reports on assessment results to your building staff and students

"I feel like the NWEA does show the effectiveness of our programs, it is a universal tool to use."

"I feel like we are lacking assessments on reading progress at the high school level. I am not sure who would proctor such assessment, but I know that we could do better with data on our kiddos with weaknesses in reading comprehension with more data. The current data that I use on addressing IEP goals is based on reading comprehension quizzes/ tests that are given through Language Arts classes."

#### District Assessment Committee Feedback Questions and Responses

What examples do we have of effective uses of data across the district?

"NWEA is very effective in my opinion within the general classroom"

"The NWEA and MAP test are good for grades 3-8, the NWEA covers the younger grades also."

Where are we generating data that we are not using effectively?

"I find MAP data to be less effective and useful than NWEA"

"The data that has been made available to us in the last couple of years has been helpful to me while developing interventions for students."

"At this time I can not think of any opportunities we are missing."
